MEMORANDUM

Subject: Elementary Education Bolsistas, Fiscal Year 1960

In our meeting of you, I and Mr. Raymond San Giovanni,
September 15, we reached the following agreements regarding the
selection of Elementary Education bolsistas for Fiscal Year 1960:

1. You have approved the three-month study and observa-
tion proposal for Professor Leôncio Amaral, PABAE, and Professor Heládio Cesar Gonçalves Antunha, CRPE, São Paulo, to visit Indiana University and selected elementary education institutions from approximately April 15 to July 15, 1960. You will inform Dr. Azevedo, CRPE, São Paulo, of this decision so we may proceed with the necessary documentation.
2. We have concurred in the proposal to send approximately seven bolsistas from PABAE in Belo Horizonte and approximately six bolsistas from São Paulo in various subject matter areas for a full year's training at Indiana University according to the following proposal:

You will write to Dr. Azevedo, CRPE, São Paulo, to authorize Professor Antunha to begin recruiting the bolsistas from São Paulo.

3. You will study our proposal to allocate three one-year study bolsas for staff members from INEP; the State Secretariat of Education, Minas Gerais; and/or PABAE to study administration for one year in a U.S. university. It is planned that these bolsistas will be high-level personnel who will be responsible for carrying out the PABAE program in Belo Horizonte when United States assistance terminates in approximately June, 1961.

4. You will inform us soon of your suggestions for utilizing the remaining five positions we have in our budget. These may be used for either six-month or three-month observation and study bolsas.

If any of the above information is contrary to your understanding of our joint decisions, please inform us immediately so that we may make any necessary changes in our planning.
